



JCCI SINGAPORE FOUNDATION SCHOLARSHIPS TO WASEDA UNIVERSITY & INTERNATIONAL CHRISTIAN UNIVERSITY (ICU) ONE-YEAR STUDY PROGRAMME 2019/2020

The Japanese Chamber of Commerce & Industry (JCCI) Singapore Foundation established the scholarship programme in 1995 to commemorate Singapore's 30th Year of National Independence and the 5th Anniversary of JCCI Singapore Foundation with the objectives to provide young Singaporeans an opportunity to study in Japan, as well as to promote further exchanges and cooperation between Singapore and Japan. **The successfully awarded scholar is thus expected to play the role of a diplomat with the task of strengthening bilateral relations between the two nations during and after the scholarship programme.**

Currently, JCCI Singapore Foundation is offering **two** scholarships to local undergraduates for a one-year study (September 2019 to July 2020) programme in Japan, in cooperation with Waseda University and International Christian University (ICU) respectively.

NATURE OF SCHOLARSHIP

JCCI Singapore Foundation provides full sponsorship up to a maximum of S\$50,000 which includes a two-way air ticket, tuition fees, daily expenses, accommodation and transportation allowances. There is strictly **no bond** attached to the scholarship. The awarded candidate will have to stay in the dormitory arranged by the respective university and the Foundation.

WASEDA UNIVERSITY - SCHOOL OF INTERNATIONAL LIBERAL STUDIES

Waseda University is a private institution of higher learning located in Tokyo, Japan. It has a long tradition of being a pioneer in international activities in education and research. The School of International Liberal Studies (SILS), previously known as the international division, was established in 1963 for foreign students to provide an opportunity for effective short-term study of Japan and Asia. Each year, approximately 120 international students are admitted to the programme. Nationalities of those international students range from the USA, Europe, Asian countries and others. The programme is basically conducted in English unless otherwise stated, and Japanese Language courses at different levels are available. INTERNATIONAL CHRISTIAN UNIVERSITY - THE COLLEGE OF LIBERAL ARTS

International Christian University (ICU) was founded in 1949, and holds as its mission the establishment of an academic tradition of freedom and reverence based on Christian ideals, and the education of individuals of conscience, internationally cultured and with a strong sense of citizenship in a democratic society. Being Japan's pioneer Liberal Arts College, ICU offers 31 majors in the arts, humanities, social and natural sciences. Many Japan-related courses are offered and a successful 'One-Year Regular' student will be given a certificate in completing the Japan Studies Certificate Programme. ICU has consistent focus on small-group education and bilingualism in Japanese and English. "Dialogue" has been placed the heart of learning and the student-to-full-time faculty ratio at ICU is 18 to 1. Japanese Language Programme (JLP) has been providing Japanese language courses to ICU students as part of College of Liberal Arts, and is to help students achieve greater competence in comprehending and producing both spoken and written Japanese, particularly in respect to carrying on academic studies in Japan. CRITERIA

- Applicants **must be** Singapore citizens and **current** university undergraduates.
- **Students in the first year of study & graduating before or in the year 2019, need NOT apply.**
- Applicants with some basic knowledge of the Japanese language will be preferred.
- Applicants must have genuine interest in Japan.
- He/ She must be physically healthy.

OTHER CONDITIONS

- Interested candidates may apply for both scholarships at the same time but would only be awarded either one upon successful screenings.
- Short-listed candidates must present themselves for an interview at JCCI Singapore Foundation office in early November 2018 with details to be informed by the Secretariat by mid-October 2018.
- The awarded scholar will be invited to attend a scholarship presentation ceremony in December 2018.
- **The scholar must be able to leave for Japan between the last week of August and the first week of September 2019.** Full attendance is expected for all lectures until the end of the course.
- The scholar is to submit a study report and give a presentation on his/her stay in Japan at the end of the course, upon returning to Singapore. JCCI Singapore Foundation might request the scholar to update his/her studying progress from time to time.
- **Whether credits earned in both Waseda University and ICU could be transferred to the home university, the scholar is to check with his/her respective school administrator.**
- The scholar is expected to assist in the JCCI Singapore Foundation's activities when required.

 - a typewritten essay explaining your objectives for studying in Japan (A4-sized, two to three pages)
 - a non-returnable passport-sized photograph (Please attach to the application form)

***DO NOT staple your documents. Please use paper clip and arrange the documents in following sequence: -**

1. Application Form
 2. Essay
 3. Birth certificate photocopy
 4. Photocopies of official transcripts, school results (starting from secondary school), testimonials, awards and other educational certificates
 5. Recommendation letters
