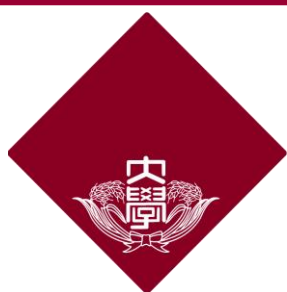

Background of our scholarship programs

In 1995, the JCCI Singapore Foundation set up no-bond scholarship programs to commemorate Singapore's 30th Year of National Independence and the 5th Anniversary of JCCI Singapore Foundation. Since then, collaborations with various universities in Japan have been further established with the aim to provide young Singaporeans an opportunity to study in Japan each year. Through such collaborations, the Foundation also wishes to promote further exchanges and cooperation between Singapore and Japan. JCCI scholars are thus expected to play the role of a diplomat, with the task of strengthening bilateral relations between the two nations during and after the scholarship programs.

Currently, the Foundation is offering two scholarships to local undergraduates for one-year (September to July) study programs in Japan, in cooperation with Waseda University and International Christian University (ICU).
